**St. Joseph's Pre-Season
Holiday Invitational Double Elimination
Basketball Tournament
November 2009**

1. The Tournament will consist of the following divisions:

7/8 year old boys	CANNOT have reached the age of 9 before <u>April 1, 2010.</u>
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7/8 year old girls	CANNOT have reached the age of 9 before <u>April 1, 2010.</u>
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9/10 year old boys	CANNOT have reached the age of 11 before <u>April 1, 2010.</u>
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9/10 year old girls	CANNOT have reached the age of 11 before <u>April 1, 2010.</u>
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11/12 year old boys	CANNOT have reached the age of 13 before <u>September 1, 2009.</u>
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11/12 year old girls	CANNOT have reached the age of 13 before <u>September 1, 2009.</u>
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13/14 year old boys	CANNOT have reached the age of 15 before <u>September 1, 2009.</u>
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13/14 year old girls	CANNOT have reached the age of 15 before <u>September 1, 2009.</u>
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2. **It will be a double elimination tournament starting Monday, November 16 and completing on or about Saturday, December 12, 2009.**
3. A team may consist of no more than (15) players; however, only (15) trophies will be awarded to the winning tournament team. A player may only play in one division in this tournament.
4. The 7/8 year old Divisions will play with an 8-ft. high basket. The 9/10 year old girls will play with a 9-ft. high basket. The 9/10 year old boys, 11/12 year old girls and boys (Junior Divisions), and the 13/14 year old boys and girls (Senior Divisions) will play with the standard 10-ft. high basket.
5. A. The intermediate size ball (28.5) will be used in all divisions except the 13/14 year old boys division, where the regulation size basketball will be used.

- B. PANTS WITH POCKETS, EARRINGS OR BRAIDED HAIR WITH BEADS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
6. A. In the 9/10 year old girls division full court pressing will be allowed only the last minute of each half, if there is no greater than a (10) point lead. Penalty for this violation will be a technical foul. **THERE WILL NOT BE A WARNING!**
- B. In the 7/8 boys and 7/8 girls divisions the defensive line will be the gray line that is just past half court. The offensive team has (20) seconds to go from the baseline past the gray line on the other side of the half court line
- C. The defensive line will be at half court the last minute of each half if the score is not greater than (10) points.
- D. Violation of this rule will result in a technical foul. **THERE IS NO WARNING!**
7. Length of games:
- A. For the 7/8 year old divisions and the 9/10 year old boys and girls division, eight minute quarters (clock runs for first seven minutes and will stop during the last minute). The 11/12 year old boys division and the 13/14 year old divisions will use (2) twelve minute halves (stop clock). Jr. Girls (11/12) will play (2) ten minute halves(stop clock).
- B. Five minute warm-up period.
- C. One minute between quarters for the 7/8 and 9/10 year old divisions.
- D. Three minutes for Overtime periods with clock running first two minutes of the overtime period for the 7/8 and 9/10 year old divisions. The 11/12 and 13/14 year old divisions will be governed by the rules of the Trident Basketball Association. (3 minutes with stop clock)
- E. Four time outs per game. Can be carried over from the 1st half to the 2nd half. Time out buzzer will sound at 45 seconds.
- F. Three point goal will be used in all Divisions.
8. **MOST IMPORTANT:** EACH PLAYER MUST PLAY EACH HALF. THE AMOUNT OF TIME A PLAYER PLAYS IS A COACH'S CALL (CLOCK MUST BE RUNNING). VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL BE FORFEITURE OF THE GAME. ENSURE THAT PLAYERS NOTIFY SCOREKEEPER WHEN REPORTING INTO GAME. **SCOREKEEPER'S DECISION IS FINAL ON PARTICIPATION.** PENALTY FOR NON-PLAYING IS FORFEITURE OF THE GAME.
9. Any player or coach ejected during a game by an Official will receive a one (1) game suspension. A second ejection at any time; not necessarily in the same game, will result in permanent suspension for the remainder of this tournament and future participation at St. Joseph's.

10. Remember that this tournament is also used as a “Training” ground for new officials.
11. A copy of a player’s birth certificate must be on file with the Tournament Director by October 30th. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE!!!! Non-participation is the penalty for non-compliance.
12. Locker rooms are available for use. Visiting teams will use Men’s locker room, located to the right as you enter the gym and home teams will use the Women’s locker room, located all the way to the right past the seating area. Please leave the markers on the white boards so the next team can utilize them.
13. **ADMISSION:** Admission to games will be \$1.00 per person. A concession stand will be operational. Each player, coach and cheerleader will be given a cold refreshment immediately following their game. Please do not bring drinks back into the gym for a team meeting. Accidents tend to happen at this time.
14. Team awards will be presented to the First, Second and Third place teams in each division with individual awards only to the First Place Team in each division.
15. Tournament Rosters **MUST** have (3) required signatures & turned in by Monday, November 2. Parental Authorization and Medical Release Form must also be filled out and submitted along with Birth Certificates. Non-participation is penalty for non-compliance.
16. Fee for the tournament will be \$80.00 per team. The 7/8 Year Old Division fee will be \$50.00 per team.
17. **Deadline for entry fee is Monday, October 26, 2009.** Entries will be limited. Fees must be paid at this time. Checks can be made payable to Athletic Association of St. Joseph or AASTJ.
